- Policies and guidelines are set by UCOP and are specific to the use of UC funds
- It is our responsibility as leaders to ensure we are familiar with these policies and enforce them
- Exceeding the per person amounts may leave your employees subject to additional taxable income

Policy Guideline Highlights – Allowable Expenses

Types of Events:

- Holiday Gatherings
- Retirement Celebrations to honor a departing employee who is retiring or separating with at least 5 years of services
- Employee recognition receptions (eg. annual staff picnic; new employee welcome reception)

Per person meal limits – increase effective November 1, 2021*:

- Breakfast \$27 → \$28
- Lunch \$47 → \$49
- Dinner \$81 → \$85
- Light Refreshments \$19 → \$20

Retirement Celebrations:

- Human Resources will support up to \$1,000 in funding
- Moffitt Catering is preferred catering vendor

Employee Gifts – meant to be <u>occasional</u>; no more than 3 per year; maximum <u>\$75 limit per gift</u>

- Recognition
- Prizes/Door Prizes/Raffle Prizes
- Gifts to acknowledge a birth
- Sympathy gifts
- NEW! All events must comply with COVID guidelines (coronavirus.ucsf.edu/events)



Policy Guideline Highlights – Unallowable Expenses

Catering for virtual events

Per UCOP policy you are not permitted to send catering to remote employees. This includes sending food via meal delivery services or purchasing gift cards for meal delivery services.

Types of Events:

- Occasions of a personal nature including Birthdays, Weddings & Anniversaries
- Farewell gatherings for employees with less than 5 years of service


Types of Gifts:

- Of a personal nature including Birthday, Anniversary, Wedding & Graduation
- **Holiday**
- Cash
- Recreation Memberships
- Season Tickets
- Services (i.e., a spa certificate)
- Retirement gifts & length of service gifts (provided by HR via BiWorldwide)
- Any expenses considered lavish or extravagant

Scenarios of Allowable & Unallowable Expenses






Sending cookies to your remote team

- Create a raffle & award prizes


FOR REMOTE WORKERS
