BRADEN DIABETES CENTER

The Braden Diabetes Center, which opened in late 2013, is an ADA-approved comprehensive outpatient diabetes center that provides care, support, education, and consultation/treatment. It is a consultative service on referral from more than 400 Bay Area practitioners. The Center also serves as a bridge clinic to help hospitalized patients manage their diabetes in transition. The team at Braden Diabetes Center includes endocrinologists, certified diabetes educators, RDs, an NP and RN staff. They are a CMS approved Diabetes Prevention Program as well. The Braden Diabetes Center hosts diabetes services for OB/Perinatology consultants for gestational diabetes and also hosts pediatric endocrinology consultants of the UCSF Madison Clinic for pediatric diabetes. Dr. Sharleen Sidhu serves as the Medical Director.

MARINHEALTH MEDICAL CENTER

MarinHealth Medical Center is a 327-bed independent hospital with deep roots in the community. They have been meeting the healthcare needs of the North Bay in the Greater San Francisco Bay Area since first opening their doors as Marin General Hospital in 1952. The hospital has grown right along with the community. A 116- bed addition was built in 1961. In 1981, Cedar Pavilion was opened. To keep up with the North Bay's burgeoning population and meet California's latest earthquake safety standards, Oak Pavilion, a 260,000-square-foot, state-of-the-art new hospital replacement building, was introduced in Fall 2020.

The Level III trauma center and emergency department receives 70% of the County's ambulance traffic, and provides life-saving care for stroke and heart attack patients. They also offer the only hospital-based labor and delivery unit in Marin County. The community's patients count on the Medical Center for advanced medical expertise, technology, and sophisticated treatments in an exceptional healing environment. In keeping with their commitment of treating the whole person—body, mind, and spirit—they also offer patients the opportunity to complement their medical treatment with integrative therapies at their Integrative Wellness Center.

As a district hospital owned by Marin Healthcare District, MarinHealth Medical Center answers only to the community they serve. This gives the hospital the flexibility to plan care that truly addresses their community needs. Building on a decades-long relationship, MarinHealth and UCSF Health have formed a strategic alliance that expands access to high-quality clinical care in Marin County and throughout the North Bay.
